| Bellringers maintaining <br> social distance <br> guidelines | Ring only alternate bells (1,3,5 or 2,4,6) <br> Ringers wear face masks. |  |
| Surface contact issues | Never less than 72 hours between ringing <br> sessions. <br> Ringers sanitise hands both before and <br> after ringing. <br> Only one person in contact with spider to <br> lower/raise ropes. |  |
| Bellringer has problems <br> during ringing | Only experienced ringers will be in <br> attendance. <br> However if there is a problem then safety <br> of ringer and assistance with rope and bell <br> will override social distancing needs. | Bellringers in contact <br> with congregation. |
| Access to ringing floor is only available <br> via main church entrance. <br> Bellringers will arrive 25 mins before <br> majority of congregation to minimise <br> contact. <br> Wear masks on entering the church and <br> walk straight to ground floor ringing space. <br> When all ringers present then space will be <br> barricaded. <br> At end of session ringers will either join <br> congregation or depart by walking straight <br> to exit. | Arrival and <br> departure will be <br> guided by ushers as <br> required. |  |
